Welcome to the second bulletin for Toowoomba 2021.

Toowoomba 2021 is an APF- accredited National One-Frame Stamp Exhibition hosted by the Toowoomba Stamp Club.

### The Venue

The Exhibition will be held at the Toowoomba Indoor Bowls Club (TIBC), 10 Annand St, Toowoomba – centrally located in the Toowoomba CBD. The hall will accommodate displays, dealers and information tables, and a small lecture area, with a separate refreshments area.



An adjacent carpark (paid until 11.30 am Saturday, free at other times) provides adequate parking.

The Toowoomba Stamp Club has formed a dedicated committee in conjunction with QPC and APF to make this Exhibition a memorable event.

## How To Get To The Exhibition

Toowoomba is approximately 120 kilometres west of Brisbane.

**DRIVING:** From Brisbane airport, it is approximately 1¾ hours driving via the Gateway Motorway, Logan Motorway, Ipswich Motorway and Warrego Highway.

**BUS:** Both Greyhound (<https://www.greyhound.com.au/travel-information/timetables>) and Murrays ([www.murrays.com.au](http://www.murrays.com.au)) offer coach services from Brisbane (City coach terminal and Brisbane Airport), generally departing at hourly intervals. Bus Queensland (<https://www.busqldoutback.com.au/toowoomba>), twice daily. Duration ranges from 2 to 3 hours, depending on route deviations.

**AIR:** Currently, all passenger flights to and from Toowoomba West (Wellcamp) Airport are suspended, and it is not known if they will be restored prior to October. Brisbane Airport is the nearest airport (driving time 1hr45min), serviced by both Qantas ([www.qantas.com.au](http://www.qantas.com.au)) and Virgin ([www.virginaustralia.com.au](http://www.virginaustralia.com.au)). Gold Coast Airport (driving time 2hr45min) is an alternative.

Toowoomba West (Wellcamp) Airport is approximately 20 minutes drive west of Toowoomba CBD and **normally** offers direct flights from Sydney (Qantas, [www.qantas.com.au](http://www.qantas.com.au)), Melbourne and Townsville (Airnorth, [www.airnorth.com.au](http://www.airnorth.com.au)), and various Qld regional centres (Rex, [www.rex.com.au](http://www.rex.com.au)). Hire cars, and a shuttle service is available from the terminal.

## Free Shuttle Service

The Exhibition's central CBD location, with many excellent accommodation options an easy walk away, means that many visitors will have no trouble getting around on foot. For those who require travel assistance, TSC members will be available to transport visitors between their accommodation and the TIBC. While not entirely "on-demand", the TSC members will endeavour to meet as many requests as possible. Advance notice of your requirements would be appreciated.

### Cobb+Co Museum

A modern museum on the old times of horse-drawn carriages and steam trains. Cobb+Co Museum is equipped with interactive displays and heritage trade workshops in silversmithing, millinery, whip plaiting and blacksmithing.

It was initially established to house the Cobb+Co collection of W.R.F. Bolton, consisting of over thirty 19<sup>th</sup> Century horse-drawn vehicles collected and restored by him.







## Russell Street Historical Walk

A self-guided walking tour of Toowoomba's Russell Street will take you back to the 1860s. Russell Street was originally known as Farm Road – a dirt track used by squatters from the west to transport their sheep and cattle to Brisbane.

In 1954 it was renamed Russell Street after Henry Stuart Russell, an early Toowoomba resident whose various occupations included grazier, explorer, politician, author, and gentleman.

You will see the Railway Station, St. James' Anglican Church, Vacy Hall, Clifford House to Toowoomba Post Office and Old Flour Mill among the ornate appearance of Russell Street and pleasant cafes, shops and the Irish Pub.

## Preston Peak Wines

Situated high on the Great Dividing Range and overlooking the Lockyer Valley, Preston has an elevation of 860 m, making a perfect spot for quality cool-climate wines which are distinctly richer in flavour due to the cooler climate.

A perfect location to appreciate fine wine and soak in the spectacular scenery. The Preston Village Chapel, which has been carefully restored, is also an ideal location for weddings



## Toowoomba's Street Art

Very close to the Exhibition is Neil Street, where the action is on graffiti murals. A giant outdoor art gallery with over 50 murals to stare up at and spend a great time weaving in and out of buildings.

If you are a lover of art, you will enjoy this other aspect of Toowoomba, bringing together local and world-class artists who put the city into emerging street art.

## Woolshed at Jondaryan

The Toowoomba Region also goes back to colonial times. Jondaryan, about 40 km from Toowoomba, is the oldest and largest woolshed in the world, still in operation. Over 160 years of history, all in one spot.

At the same time, the woolshed has a caravan, camping and cabin accommodation with equipped, pet-friendly camping grounds and cafes operating all week long.



## Table Top Mountain

Located at the edge of Toowoomba, Table Top Mountain is a park of volcanic origin, recognized in the Aboriginal Culture Heritage Register. The trek to the summit is not an easy feat – expect rock scrambling and loose gravel with no shade spot to rest along this Grade Five unmarked track. Caution needs to be taken during this walk.

While the track will get your heart pumping as the elevation rises to 700 metres, you'll be rewarded with panoramic views of Lockyer Valley to the east and Main Range to the south.
